Grants

We raise funds for and make grants to Somerset's voluntary, community and social enterprise sector. Our grants strengthen communities by tackling disadvantage across our county, connecting our donors with the causes they care most about.

Foundation grants

Grants range from £250 to £5,000 and our average grant is around £2,500. We distribute over £500,000 a year supporting:

- Vulnerable, isolated and lonely older people
- Disadvantaged rural communities with poor access to services
- Disadvantaged children and young people
- People living with, or recovering from, mental ill-health

We are particularly keen to support:

- Grassroots voluntary groups (usually with a turnover of under £50,000) with funds for their core costs, capital purchases, and specific projects
- Small/medium-sized groups (usually with a turnover of under £1 million) with funds to help them become more efficient or effective
- The growth of community-led groups in the most disadvantaged areas of our county

We also fund individuals and other areas of work.

Hinkley Point C Community Funds

Funding is available from two Hinkley Point C grant programmes for projects that will benefit one or more communities within Somerset, to help mitigate the impacts and increase the opportunities of the Hinkley Point C project.

Small Grants Programme

Our Small Grants Programme (usually up to £5,000) is for organisations or community groups with an annual income of less than £100,000. Grant applications must show ways in which the project will improve economic, social and environmental well-being and enhance quality of life.

Strategic Grants Programme

Our Strategic Grants Programme targets specific impacts felt within Somerset communities, as a result of Hinkley Point C. We invite expressions of interest to be submitted before shortlisting applicants who will be invited to submit a full application.
